Isaiah 60:22

1. They say that “time flies.” How do you perceive the passage of time? Why is it that sometimes time seems to go swiftly and other times it seems to go slowly? What might this say about our understanding of eternity?
2. We believe that God is eternal, which is to say that he exists outside of time. What implications does this understanding have for our appreciation of the passage of time?
3. Isaiah makes a number of promises to his people in chapter 59 and 60. How have those promises been fulfilled already?
4. Isaiah 61 picks up direct prophetic references to Jesus which are identified in Luke 4. How can we see Jesus in Isaiah’s prophecy and how does that encourage us today?
5. Like the nation of Israel, we sometimes experience times of suffering. How are we helped by knowing the history of God’s promises to his people and how he has fulfilled many of those promises already?
6. What are you anticipating from God for your own future in faith with him.
