

"Kinda" like children expecting to feel older, and smarter the day after their birthday. But sadly, things are very much the same. The only encouraging element is our Lord's consistency. He is with us. He has not forsaken us, and He is not surprised by the situation we are in. Thank you, Jesus. We were blessed to spend a few days with John and his family just before Christmas. Then we had a wonderful Christmas with our son Aaron and his family. It is a treat to be able to easily see our children. Quite a difference from the long-distance visits we have been used to. On Sunday the 10th I will be taking a small group down to Mexico to build the first house of 2021. We feel led by the Lord to pick up where we left off. The Kalongas

Life for us in Zambia is going on well by the grace of God, in spite of the economy not being good, and the fact that Covid has impacted us greatly. Church attendance is down. We expect only about 30 people for Christmas Eve service, and maybe 50 for a Christmas Day celebration. Covid cases in Mongu are increasing and church leaders are set to have a meeting with government authorities in order to implement more protective measures. On a positive note, we have finally opened the school at the church! We have 41 children and 2 teachers! The Sunday school shelter which was rebuilt with your support has now been painted, and we also managed to get some furniture and supplies for the school. We thank God for your support! The church is having elections for leadership in January and we appreciate prayer for that. Also pray for our youth who make up the majority in the church--they are doing well! We are also planning to expand our church building as it is old and cracking and it needs to meet town standards. Pray for us as a family for wisdom, grace and provisions as we shepherd His people at Mongu ECZ.
