Open in Prayer  
Read Luke 11: 1-13

1. Vs 3. What are your daily bread needs? Have they changed over the past year?
2. How do you define 'Emotional Quotient' (EQ)? What purpose does it serve to have a lower EQ (greater boldness, persistence, shameless audacity) when going to God in prayer? Does it help to change God's mind or decision? Does it change anything in you to have a lower EQ in prayer?
3. How does a proper perspective of our relationship to an Almighty / Sovereign God impact how we go to Him in prayer, bearing in mind Sunday morning's message?
4. Many people (including non-believers) will state that they pray. Pastor Brent mentioned in the message that only true believers can approach God as 'Abba Father'. Why is that?
5. Vs. 13. Why is the gift of the Holy Spirit the ultimate gift to us as believers, even much better than God granting us the needs mentioned in question 1 above?
6. All believers, upon confession of their faith in Jesus as Lord and Savior, are given the gift of the Holy Spirit. Why then should we pray for the gift of the Holy Spirit for believers?
7. In what areas of your life do you desire comfort, empowerment, and/or guidance in truth (all roles of the Holy Spirit)? Are you willing to ask others to pray these things for you?
