Scripture Reading:

Isaiah 43: 1-7 (paraphrased)

Do not be afraid. I have called you by name.
I will pay whatever it takes to win you back to me.
I would give away whole continents as a ransom, if that’s what it took.
I’d pay the highest price you could imagine,
and much more, just to bring you home.
I created you and you are mine.
I will always keep you safe. Wild rushing torrents won’t sweep you away.
Fire won’t hurt you. Nothing will ever cause you harm.
You are precious in my eyes, and honoured and trusted. I love you. I am with you.

Luke 3:15-17, 21-22 [NRSV]

As the people were filled with expectation, and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John, whether he might be the Messiah, John answered all of them by saying, “I baptize you with water; but one who is more powerful than I is coming; I am not worthy to untie the thong of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.
