6. If you were given someone else's money, and told, invest it however you wish, would you handle money differently than you do now? Why or why not? How does it change your thinking regarding money, realizing none of what you have is actually yours to keep, you are simply a manager?
7. When you take inventory of your money, where it is spent, and used, and invested and saved, do you find you are shrewd in the ways of the world or the ways of the light?
