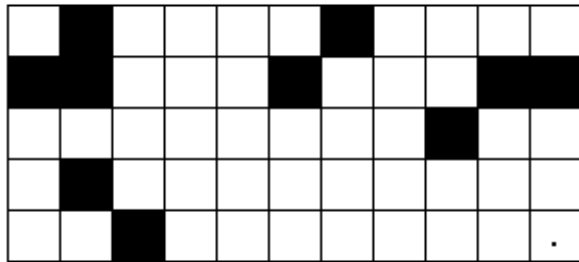


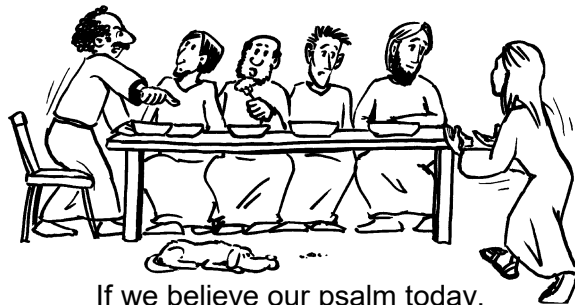

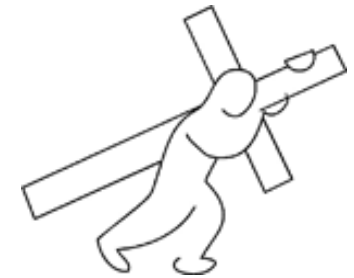

### Today's lessons:

Genesis 17:1-7, 15-16 Abram and Sarai receive new names and God's promise: they will become the ancestors of many people.

Psalms 22:23-31 If bad things like poverty happen to people, that is not a sign that God has turned his back on them; even death doesn't mean God has forsaken someone.

Romans 4:13-25 Abraham had faith in God's faithfulness and believed God would keep his promise to give him countless descendants. And God liked that about Abraham.

Mark 8:31-38 Just after Peter has confessed Jesus as the Messiah, Jesus explains to him and the other disciples that he will have to suffer and die, and then will rise again. Peter doesn't like the idea, but Jesus tells him that indeed all his followers will have to suffer, too.
