Litany of Partnership with God - Isaiah 58

God says: Is not this the fast that I choose:

**to loose the bonds of injustice,
to undo the thongs of the yoke,
to let the oppressed go free,
and to break every yoke?**

Is it not to share your bread with the hungry,
and bring the homeless poor into your house?

**when you see the naked, to cover them,
and not to hide yourself from your own kin?**

Then your light shall break forth like the dawn,
and your healing shall spring up quickly.

**If you remove the yoke from among you,
the pointing of the finger, the speaking of evil,

and satisfy the needs of the afflicted,

Blessing and Commissioning – from II Corinthians 5

If anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation:

Everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!

All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ,

Now God gives us the ministry of reconciliation.

In Christ, God was reconciling the world to himself – not counting their trespasses against them - and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us.

So we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us.

For our sake God made him to be sin who knew no sin,

So that, in him, we might become the righteousness of God.

We entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.
