

Associate Pastor Search



The Associate Pastor will serve as the primary overseer of congregational life at Northgate Baptist Church. Currently this is a temporary and part-time position.

The Associate Pastor will assume primary responsibility for the provision of:

- Support to small group ministries
 - Provide leadership and planning for fellowship opportunities and events
 - Develop a strategy for intentional discipleship within small group ministries
- Membership Care including such supports as:
 - Follow up of new people and first time visitors
 - Integrating attendees into the church body
 - Interviewing and preparing individuals for baptism and/or membership
- Support to Deacons
- Pastoral care including such supports as:
 - Hospital visitation
 - Support to Seniors and/or shut-ins
 - Scheduled and drop-in counseling services
 - Benevolent requests

The Associate Pastor will assume secondary responsibility to:

- Provide ongoing support to the Senior Pastor including:
 - Pulpit coverage as required on an intermittent basis
 - Planning and conducting special events such as weddings, funerals, and premarital counseling
 - Assisting the Senior Pastor in the overall programming of the church, and implementing specific assignments related to general pastoral duties as directed by the Pastor
 - Meeting regularly and communicating effectively with the Pastor and ministerial staff for planning, evaluating, and coordinating the ministries of the church
- Provide ongoing leadership by:
 - Supervising and assisting ministerial staff in planning, coordinating, and implementing programs related to their areas of responsibility
 - Conducting regular reviews of performance based on program objectives and goals
