Luke 10:27 (NKJV)- So he answered and said, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind," and "your neighbor as yourself."

Luke 10:30-37 (NKJV)-Jesus gives them an example of what it looks like (good Samaritan)

1. All your heart

What is the current condition of your heart? How would God respond?

Psalms 139:23-24 (NKJV)-Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.

What was it that the Priest and the Levite held dearly?

Matthew 6:21(NKJV)- For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Like David we must get back to the HEART of the matter as God intended.

Psalms 51:10(NKJV)- Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

2. All your Soul

The human soul is central to the personhood of a human being. As **George MacDonald** said, "You don't have a soul. You are a Soul. You have a body."

The human soul is created by God

Jeremiah 38:16(NKJV)- "As the Lord lives, who made our very souls,


If it does not Line up with the word it can be lost, but God made a way to save the Soul.

1 Peter 1:22(NKJV)- Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart,

3. All your Strength



We tend to grow weary of doing good because we think we have given everything we could to a person only to for “our good works” to go unnoticed. (I am only giving of myself and not God)

Galatians 6:9(NKJV)- And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.

This can cause us to second guess or not help at all when someone (neighbor) is in need, walking to the other side.

We are able to Love with “ALL” when it comes from God (consider the source)

Philippians 2:13 (AMP)-For it is [not your strength, but it is] God who is effectively at work in you, both to will and to work [that is, strengthening, energizing, and creating in you the longing and the ability to fulfill your purpose] for His good pleasure.

4. All your Mind

As we see the first 2 men that did not stop was according to the mindset they had, finding the man naked and looking dead.

Old thought process- can you blame them for not stopping?

Luke 10:30(NKJV)- and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded him, and departed, leaving him **half dead. (looking to be dead)**

Numbers 19:11 (NKJV)-‘He who touches the dead body of anyone shall be unclean seven days.

Luke 7:14(NKJV)- Jesus thinks differently to raise the boy of Widow of Nain (touching the coffin)

Romans 12:2 (NKJV)- be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Closing: The Lawyer knew the right answers, but that is not enough to just know the word but also be doers of the Word.

Luke 10:28(NKJV)- And He said to him, “You have answered rightly; do this and you will live.”

Luke 10:37(NKJV)- Then Jesus said to him, “Go and do likewise.”

Lamentations 3:40(NKJV)- Let us search out and examine our ways, And turn back to the Lord;
