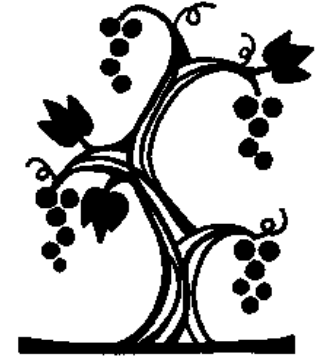

Fifth Sunday of Easter

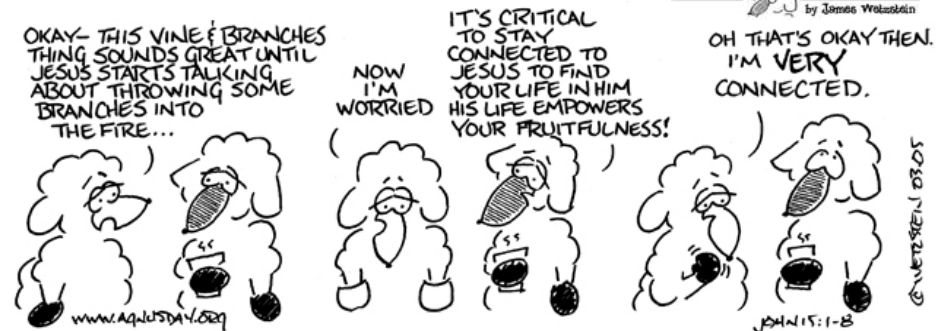

Today's lessons:

- Acts 8:26-40 The Holy Spirit sends Philip to approach a travelling Ethiopian minister who has a problem understanding a passage from Isaiah (actually Isaiah 53:7-8). Philip explains that it is a prophecy about Jesus Christ, and the Ethiopian asks Philip to baptize him.
- Psalms 22:25-31 This praise of the Lord is the end of the same psalm that Jesus started to pray on the cross: "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"
- 1 John 4:7-21 "Love one another." was the commandment Jesus left his disciples. This love is rooted in God's love for us. And not loving one another shows that our claim to love God is not true!
- John 15:1-8 At the Last Supper Jesus talks to his disciples about the time after his death. He compares their relationship to that of a vine and its branches: the branches can only bring fruit, if they stick with the vine; if they separate from it, they are dead.
